Nash was a carousel horse with purple mane and tail /brown saddle /pink and blue saddle blanket and a red chest strap with tassels all of which was sculpted into his coat. I won \$1000 so I can't complain.

As a side note, Rumor was rented by a fellow competitor for the advanced poodle class and she won ! Jackie Bolton (who is a very talented groomer from Alberta) did a simply stunning groom on Rumor.
